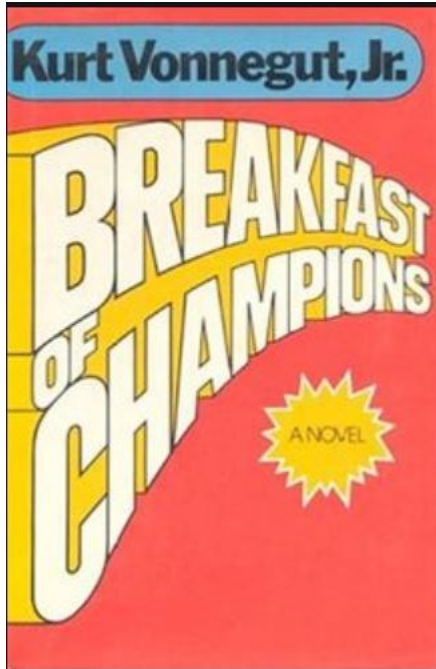
The Post is thinking of starting a Darts league. Please see Canteen Manager Dutch for details.

We need your help, ASAP.

House Bill 282 - Permit use of electronic instant bingo devices is stalled in the Senate. We need to get it moving. We need as many as possible to contact the members of the Senate Rules and Reference Committee. The committee assigns bills to committees for deliberation and until HB 282 gets assigned to a committee there will be no hearings, no testimonies, no action of any kind.

Please contact the committee members right away. The committee meets again on Tuesday, July 21. I might add that they have meet four times since 282 was introduced in the Senate and they did nothing with it.

Impress upon the Senators that all we are asking for at this time is to get the bill referred so that the process can begin. Every Senator we have talked to supports the bill but until it gets assigned to a committee that will not do us any good.

The best way to contact them is by email. That will allow the Senators staffer (that is who will see the email first) to immediately forward it to the Senator who might not be 'in the office' until Tuesday.

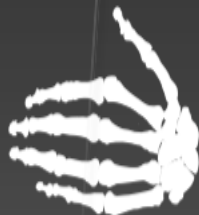

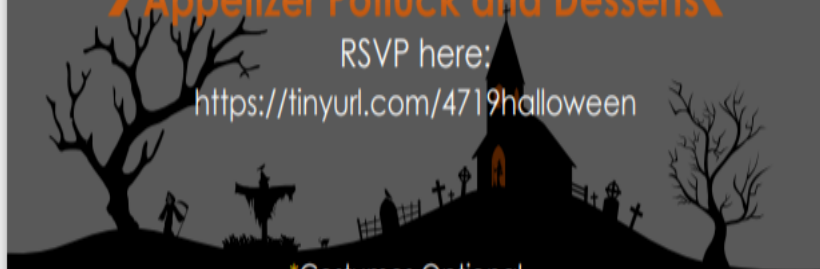
