**CHARITABLE GAMING: When the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly ended, so did our bills to legalize our machines. Work is ongoing in the 134<sup>th</sup> G.A. The new Senate President, Senator Matt Huffman created a new committee to study gaming in Ohio. It is the SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON GAMING and is holding weekly hearing and listening to testimony from all interested parties. We have had witnesses testifying on behalf of charitable gaming in the past two weeks with more to come. There is also a new bill for our machines that was introduced by the same two Representative who sponsored HB 282 for us in the last G.A. Representatives Jeff LaRe and Adam Holmes introduced House Bill 65 on February 5<sup>th</sup> and it was referred to the House Finance Committee. There has been no action as of yet. Please contact your state representative and senator to encourage them to vote for this Bill. This is where our charity money comes from folks, hence the name "Charitable Gaming"! Some want to take it away and keep these proceeds for themselves!**
